Aral Glenn Corbett, 102, of Walnut Ridge, Arkansas passed away peacefully at his home on Thursday, April 21st, 2016. He was born on Friday, June 13th, 1913, at Black Rock. Mr. Corbett was the son of the late Marion Aral and Myrtle Howard Corbett; he had three brothers, the late Marion, Herbert and Lundy Corbett.

After graduating from Walnut Ridge High School in 1933, he started his farming career in the old Walnut Ridge and Duvall areas. He then farmed south of Hoxie and in the Sedgwick area until 1982. In 1992, he began a second career involving rental property in Walnut Ridge and Hoxie. He managed several rental houses until 2013.

He served in the National Guard during World War II. He was an ordained deacon of Hoxie and Sedgwick Baptist Churches and most recently was an active member of Walnut Ridge First Baptist Church.

He is survived by his wife of 78 years, Snoda Perry Corbett. Mr. and Mrs. Corbett have five children, Glendola (John) Worlow of Walnut Ridge, David Aral (Carla) of Lexington, S.C., Charles Howard (Beth) of Loganville, Ga., Ronald Perry (Bunny) of Jonesboro, and Daniel Joseph (Vicki) of Thibodaux, La. The Corbett's have 12 grandchildren, 22 great-grandchildren and one great-great-grandchild.
