Edwin Doyle Grissom, 91 of Walnut Ridge, died August 20, 2019 at the Flo and Phil Hospice House in Jonesboro.

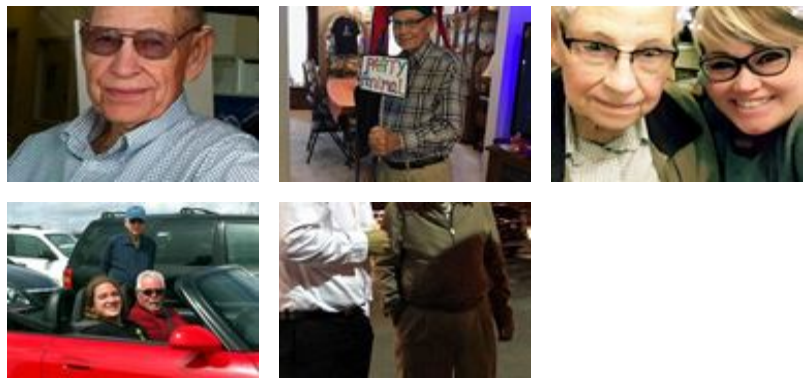
