Elza Dewayne Stone, 64 of Paragould, died February 23, 2020 in the Flo and Phil Jones Hospice House in Jonesboro.

Born February 12, 1956 in Walnut Ridge; son of the late Elza and Gertie Fay Sparks Stone. He was a 1974 graduate of Pocahontas High School. Raised a Farmer Dewayne, had a passion for gardening. He worked over 20 years as a Field Enumerator for the U.S.D.A; he owned and operated a Backhoe Service for nearly 30 years. With his son Craig, Dewayne owned and ran Stone's Auto Sales for several years and retired selling cars in Jonesboro at Cavanaugh KIA. He was an avid supporter of the Walnut Ridge Bobcats and loved watching his children play sports. He is also well known as "Dangerous Dewayne" from years of wrestling from 1974 to 2000; where he was inducted into the Mid-American Championship Wrestling Hall of Fame in 2016.

He is preceded in death by his parents; and a sister, Rita Stone.

Survivors include his son, Craig (Joanna) Stone of Jonesboro; a daughter, Sheena Stone of Pocahontas; three grandchildren, Valerie, Edica and Eliecer; and many other relatives and friends.

Funeral Service will be Friday, February 28, 2020 at 2 P.M. in the Bryan Chapel with Bro. David Smith Jr officiating. Pallbearers will be Rick Scott,

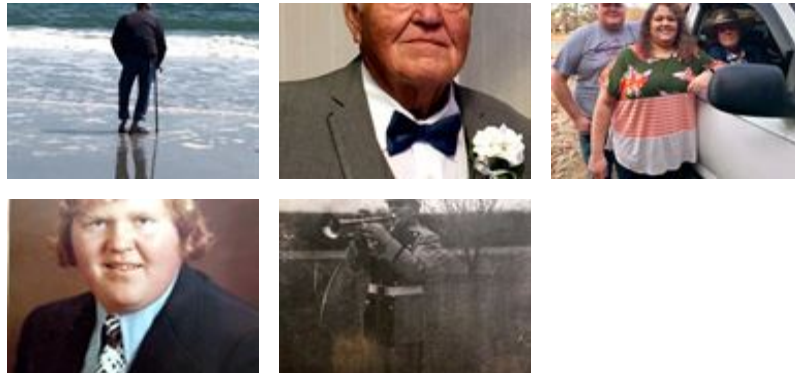
