Forrester Davis, 92 of Walnut Ridge, passed away October 21, 2018 in the Lawrence Hall Nursing Center.

Born in Walnut Ridge, December 27, 1925 to the late Charles and Madge Forrester Davis. He was a Veteran of the U.S. Navy, serving during WWII training soldiers to weld and repair Pearl Harbor. After the Navy he was a farmer and a member of the Pleasant Grove Baptist Church. He also was very proud of serving his community on the Egypt School Board and the Westside School board when they consolidated.
