Howard Allen Hoffman, 94, of Walnut Ridge, passed away Monday, May 25, 2015 at St. Bernards Medical Center in Jonesboro.

Born April 28, 1921 in Brookland, New York, son of Roy and Irene Brown Hoffman. 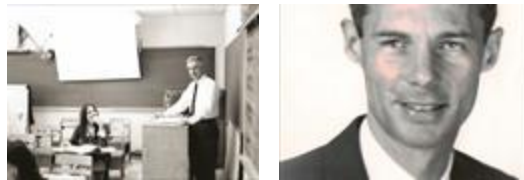
