HE HAD A BEAUTIFUL VOICE AND LOVED MARTY ROBBINS. HE MAY NOT HAVE BEEN A LEGEND IN EVERYONE'S MIND OR TIME; BUT, HE WILL ALWAYS BE ONE IN MINE AND MY SIBLINGS.

HE ALSO WAS ON TELEVISION AT A VERY YOUNG AGE OF MAYBE 12 AND SANG THE ELVIS SONG "THAT'S ALRIGHT, MAMA".

I WILL NEVER FOGET EITHER WHEN I WAS ABOUT 9 IN THE FOURTH GRADE AT CASH AND GOT TO ATTEND HIS GRADUATION OR SOMETHING. I HAD A NAME TAG AT MY PLATE JUST LIKE THE BIG GUYS. LOUISE WAS THERE ALSO.
