John Harrison Foley, 70 of Walnut Ridge, died January 15, 2019 in the St. Bernard's Medical Center.

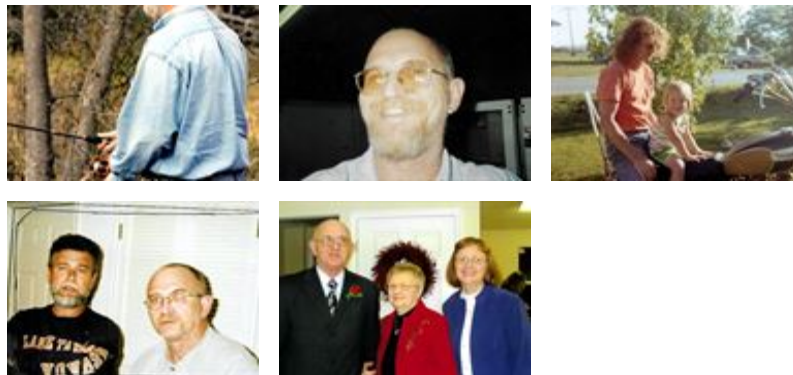
