Juanita M. Tolson, 95 of Walnut Ridge; died March 16, 2021 at her residence.

Born November 16, 1925 in Evansville, Indiana; daughter of the late Charles "C.D." and Susie Cooke Miller. One of Juanita's first jobs was working in Washington D.C. as a telephone operator for the U.S. Naval Department; that is where she met the love of her life, Enos A. (Bud) Tolson; they were later married on September 16, 1945. Upon moving to Arkansas, Mrs. Juanita continued working for Southwestern Bell Telephone company until she retired to become a mother and homemaker. She also helped the Mullen's Abstract in Walnut Ridge recording deeds and other important paperwork. Juanita was very active in life, she was a local girl scout leader; she helped deliver Meals on Wheels to the elderly and was at one time the President of the WMU. She enjoyed knitting and crocheting, spending time with her family and most of all she was an avid Bowler. She bowled in local Leagues, played with several different professional bowlers, and was named Jonesboro's Bowler of the Year once. Juanita was an active member of the First Baptist Church in Walnut Ridge.

She is preceded in death by her parents; her husband, Bud; a brother, Clint D. Miller and a half-brother, Carl Killabrew.

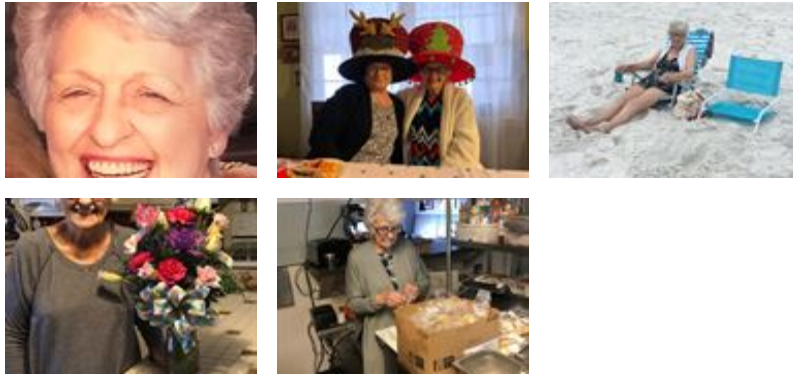
