I just, I do not know why I share this, but I need to.

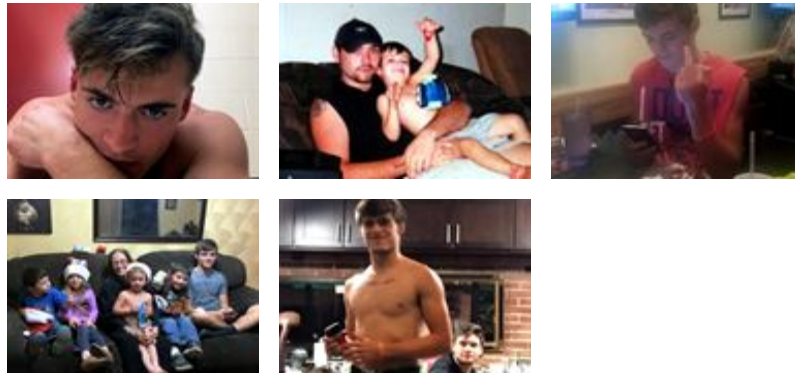
I miss the son I wish I could hold right now and hope that everyday I live as I do since then, he can someone know, I wish I had been a better man.
