Rev. Mack Evangle Gore, 88, of Portia, passed away Sunday, July 8, 2012 at St. Bernard's Regional Medical Center.

Born June 5, 1924 at Gainesville, Texas son of Elmer Elijah and Jodie Elizabeth White Gore. Mack was the tenth child of twelve; there were six boys and five girls.

Mack was a Pastor of eight different churches over fifty-five years of ministry; he retired in 2005 at the age of 82. Mack also served three years in the Navy aboard an aircraft carrier during World War II.

Mack married Betty Jo Mayes in 1945 while on leave while the ship he was stationed on was being repaired after a bomb knocked a large hole in the flight deck. Mack met his wife Betty in 1942, he fell deeply in love with her and they were married three years later.

Survivors include his son, Michael Gore and wife Peggy of Choctaw, Oklahoma; three daughters, Glenda Richardson and husband Larry of Pocahontas, Carolyn Woehl and husband Fred of Harrison and Becky Brann and fiancée Jeff Spencer of Swifton; eight grandchildren, seventeen great grandchildren and many other relatives.
