Roger Dale Tinsley, 76 of Walnut Ridge passed away December 8, 2025, at the M.D. Anderson Cancer Center in Houston, TX.

Born November 27, 1949, in Washington, son of the late Taylor and Virginia Perry Tinsley. Roger graduated from Clover Bend School and earned a degree in Engineering from Arkansas State University. He was a farmer and outdoorsman; he was awarded Lawrence County farm family of the year and served as the president of the Farm Service Board of Directors. He was active in his community serving on the Lawrence County Farm Bureau Board, Lawrence County Conservation District, Running Water Draining Board, and the Lawrence County FSA Board. He was a member of the First Baptist Church of Walnut Ridge.
