Thelma Jeanette Crosslin-Woodson of Black Rock Arkansas passed over on May 27th, 2015 at Lawrence Memorial Hospital in Walnut Ridge, AR.

She was born Nov 10th, 1941 to Wesley Woodson and Cora (Tyree) Woodson in the family home at the mouth of Spring River and was one of eight children. Jeanette graduated from Black Rock High School in May of 1960. She was a bright student and star player on the school basketball team.

After receiving her high school diploma, she attended the University of Kansas and graduated as an LPN Nurse in 1964. She later joined the US Army and served in the Vietnam War as a nurse, where she met her husband, Claude Crosslin. After living in California for a short time, they moved to Kansas City, where their daughter, Pennie Crosslin was born. They settled in Tampa, FL where they embraced tropical weather and year round sunshine.

Jeanette was a passionate, dedicated and greatly respected nurse who spent the majority of her career caring for high risk pediatric patients. She retired in 2004 and moved back to Black Rock to help care for her mother, Cora Woodson.

In her spare time, Jeanette was a free spirit who loved spending time with family and friends. She enjoyed weekend camping trips, spending time at the

beach and cherished the annual 4th of July family reunion in Black Rock.

Jeanette is survived by her daughter, Pennie Crosslin of Greenville, SC. Her granddaughter, Harmony Crosslin-Gilbert, her sibling's Nancy (Fred) Pickney, James (Diane) Woodson, Anita Sue James. Sister in-laws Sharon Woodson and Jane Woodson and many nieces and nephews.
